heaven and earth to show us
His will.

Today's Reading
Psalm 16



What is your perspective of the "will of God"? For many, God's will seems to be some elusive secret...perhaps something that God only reluctantly and occasionally allows a person to glance at. Such people go through life frustrated in not knowing what His plan for them is. In reality, God wants the best for His children and yearns to disclose His will to them. In many ways, your intimacy with God and surrender to Him will determine your ability to discern His will (Rom. 12:1, 2).

How might you expect to hear God express His will for you? He gives you direction from His word...in fact, in His word, He tells you how to relate to your boss and even who not to marry. He may speak to you while in prayer. His directions may come through a life changing experience. A godly friend may provide wise

words of counsel that help you know where to go and what to do. Even the circumstances of life...closed doors and open doors of opportunity...may be expressions of His will. God really does desire to reveal His will to you.
