

Life Principle Day Eleven:
God assumes full responsibility for our needs when we obey Him.

Today's Reading
Matthew 6:25-34



Today's walk takes you through the fields where you can watch the birds and enjoy the lilies. Just as God provides food for the birds and beauty for the flowers, so He loves to provide for your needs. Through Christ's crucifixion and resurrection, He has provided for your most vital need of salvation. Similarly, you can trust that God will meet your daily needs.

Trusting God to meet life's needs can seem difficult at times. It requires patience when it seems He is not answering your prayer. Trusting God may seem hard when you know how faithful you have been to Him and your employer has just laid you off from your job. Trusting God is hard when someone close to you is angry because his/her day did not go as well. But even at times when trust seems unreasonable, you can know that He will care for your needs if you choose to obey

Him...if you choose to give Him first place in your life.

Today's reading reminds us of God's faithful provision for the little created entities of the plant and animal world. As followers of Christ, we have been adopted into the family of God. The Father loves His children even more than the birds and flowers. God sees your day from beginning to end. He desires to meet your needs each day. But His provision for your needs is contingent upon your response to Him.

If you are seeking to love Him with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength, there is no reason for worry. When worry starts to rise, keep following and trusting faithfully. He assumes full responsibility for your needs.
