God's Word is an immovable  
anchor in times of storm.***

**Today's Reading  
Psalms 91**



In your daily walk with Christ, there will be times when your faith will come under fire. Bullets of adversity will seem to fly from every direction. You will find yourself engaged in spiritual warfare. In times like those, you will discover the word of God to be one of your greatest weapons.

Years ago, I had an experience that illustrates this principle. I was visiting my son who was graduating from Army basic training. He took me to an interesting part of the Army base that looked like a village...one you might see in the Middle East. My son informed me, "This is where I learned to control chaos." In modern day military training, it is a matter of life and death that a soldier trains his mind and heart to operate calmly in the midst of chaos while in combat. Think of the intensity of a situation where a warrior has

only a split second to assess a situation and take appropriate action that keeps him and others alive! Being able to respond calmly, quickly, and appropriately is no small challenge. The Bible provides you with that kind of ability even when the battles around you seem chaotic. Psalm 91 is one of those passages.

As a Christian soldier in a world of chaos and storms, you should be training daily with God's living Word. Just as a military soldier trains his/her heart and mind for those split second decisions, so should a Christian soldier prepare for the storms of life. Your strength comes from the Lord. His word provides you with an anchor in times of storm.
